Tuesday 23rd Mar - “I will hear from heaven and will forgive will forgive their sin and heal the Land” – an evening of response and looking outwards for the healing of our town.

The desire of the leaders of the “Church in Highworth” is that as many as possible from our congregations come together to seek God in this way. Our hope is that a wide cross-section of the “Church in Highworth” will make it a priority this Lent to seek God together.

The event will take place each Tuesday at 8pm in the URC church. So clear the diary and make every effort to attend these evenings. You may be surprised to see what God does in and through us.
